1. PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

- Ensure that the active part of the heating element is in continuous contact with the part or fluid to be heated when it is switched on.
- Check the supply voltage used is much that mentioned on the heater.

2. MAINTENANCE

Taking its simplicity and great reliability into account, the heating element needs little maintenance.

After 50 hours of operation:

- Check that the electrical connections are securely tightened.
- Check that the element is in contact with the pipe.

Every year:

- Same operation as in the previous paragraph.

3. GUARANTEE

Our guarantee is consistent with inter-union agreements of Construction Électrique of France and our general sales conditions. We guarantee compliance of any materials and finishes with the specifications in our documents.
